SH 99 Grand Parkway Construction Project

Segments H, I-1 & I-2

A TxDOT Project



What is the SH 99 Grand Parkway Project?

State Highway 99 (the Grand Parkway) is a proposed 184-mile circumferential highway traversing seven counties in the Greater Houston area. Conceptualized in the early 1960's, it is divided into 11 segments designated A through I-2.

The green segments on the map below are open to traffic; segments (H, I-1 & I-2) are currently under construction by Grand Parkway Infrastructure.



Who is Grand Parkway Infrastructure (GPI)?

GPI is a joint venture between Ferrovial Agroman US Corp., Webber LLC, and Granite Construction Inc.

The group was awarded the design-bid contract from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to construct and maintain SH99 Grand Parkway Segments H, I-1 & I-2. The \$894 million

toll road project spans 52.8 miles around northeast Houston, within Chambers, Harris, Liberty, and Montgomery counties. Construction began in Summer 2018 and will be complete Spring 2022.

Project Overview:

Segments H and I-1 are approximately 33 miles of a two-lane toll facility with intermittent four-lane sections for passing. This section extends from US-59 / I-69 N to IH 10.

Segment I-2 is comprised of Segments I-2A and I-2B. Segment I-2A consists of tolling equipment upgrades and other improvements for approximately 8.7 miles of an existing four-lane facility from FM 1405 to IH 10. Segment I-2B is approximately 6.1 miles of a new four-lane toll facility from SH 146 to FM 1405.

The project also includes:

- 80 new or substantially reconstructed bridges
- Utility relocations
- Right-of-way (ROW) acquisitions
- Aesthetic enhancements
- Corridor maintenance

Project Benefits:

The SH 99 Grand Parkway Segments H & I Project will improve:

- the connectivity within the existing transportation network by providing a circumferential link between US-59 / I-69 N, IH-10 (E), and SH 146
- reduce congestion on area roadways while providing more travel options for the motorists



- provide an alternate evacuation route to help relieve congestion during emergency evacuations
- accommodate the forecasted population growth
- the movement of people and goods to businesses, places of employment, and residential areas within the region
